2017-2018 After School Open Rec Broderick Recreation Center, Forbes Recreation Center, & Youth Park Recreation Center

Registration Opens Monday, July 3, 2017

Each afternoon during the school year, the Broderick, Forbes, and Youth Park Recreation Centers offer a variety of recreational activities for children ages 5-12 at Broderick and Forbes and 13 & up at Youth Park. These include indoor and outdoor sports and games, homework help, open game rooms, arts and crafts, and a variety of fee-based activities such as cooking classes, dance and exercise classes, and recreational sports leagues. Programs are offered from 2:00 to 6:00 pm on days when Pinellas County Schools are in session, and from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm on Pinellas County Schools holidays and professional development days.

Children ages 5 and up with a current Recreation ID Card may visit the centers without a parent or guardian present. Children who are 5 years old must be enrolled in Kindergarten to participate. Children may move freely among any of the rooms or activities that are open at a given time, including outdoor play areas. Advance registration is required for fee-based classes.

There is no fee for the drop-in Open Rec program, but space is limited, and parents or guardians must sign their child up for the program in advance in order to attend. The parent or guardian must also read and sign the Open Rec Program Guidelines and the Facility Rules of Use.

Pinellas Park Recreation is offering registration for the 2017-2018 school year during 2017 Summer Camp season. In order to reserve your space for the coming year, please visit the Forbes or Broderick Recreation Centers during the dates noted above in order to complete your registration.

Please note that a current Recreation ID Card is required for Early Registration.

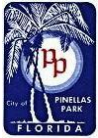

Program Guidelines

- A current Recreation ID Card and advance registration are required for participation in the Open Rec Program. Children are required to have their ID Card with them when visiting the centers.
- The Open Rec program is not a Child Care program and is not licensed by the Pinellas County License Board.
- The Pinellas Park Recreation Open Rec program is a drop-in program only. Children attending the program are permitted to move freely among indoor and outdoor activities and are permitted to freely enter or leave the program, facility, or premises.
- Children who are 5 years old must be enrolled in Kindergarten in order to participate.
- Participants in the Open Rec program are required to sign themselves in and sign out when entering and leaving Recreation Centers.
- Pinellas Park Recreation does not offer transportation to or from the Open Rec program. Parents/guardians are solely responsible for transportation to and from the program and for any contractual arrangement they may choose to enter into for the purpose of transporting children.
- Pinellas Park Recreation Staff lead recreational activities and monitor indoor and outdoor areas that are open to children. Your child will not be assigned to a specific group or counselor.
- Pinellas Park Recreation Staff are not permitted to administer any medications including aspirin or tylenol.
- Pinellas Park Recreation Staff are unable to assist in the administration of behavior plans or other intensive guidance.
- Pinellas Park Recreation discourages children from bringing valuables such as phones and electronic games to the Open Rec program. Use of these items will not be permitted without permission. Pinellas Park Recreation is not responsible for loss or theft of personal possessions brought to the facility.
- Children visiting the Recreation Centers must comply with the Facility Rules of Use. Violations of the Facility Rules of Use may result in your child being asked to leave a specific room or activity, suspension from the program for a period of one or more days, or permanent suspension from the Open Rec program or from the facility.
