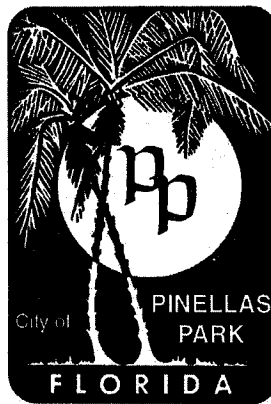

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RESOLUTION NO. XX-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PINELLAS PARK, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A MILLAGE RATE OF 5.6500 MILLS FOR AD VALOREM TAXATION OF PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 TO \$26,916,312; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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**WHEREAS**, the Property Appraiser for Pinellas County, Florida, has certified the 2022 Gross Taxable value for the City of Pinellas Park, Florida, to be \$5,014,683,170, and

**WHEREAS**, the rolled back millage rate for fiscal year 2022-2023 is 5.0251 mills, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that the revenue required from ad valorem taxes for fiscal year 2022-2023 is \$26,916,312, or 5.6500 mills based on 95 percent of Gross Taxable Value, and

**WHEREAS**, this required revenue represents an increase of \$2,976,992 based on 95 percent of Gross Taxable Value or a 12.44% increase in revenue that would be generated at the rolled back millage rate.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINELLAS PARK, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION ONE:** That there is hereby levied a millage rate of 5.6500 mills for ad valorem taxation of property within the

corporate limits of the City of Pinellas Park, Florida, for fiscal year 2022-2023.

**SECTION TWO:** That the City Manager shall be authorized to recompute the millage rate as provided by Florida Statute upon notice of revised Gross Taxable Value from the Property Appraiser for Pinellas County, Florida, such that the dollar levy remains constant.

**SECTION THREE:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its adoption and approval in the manner provided by law.
